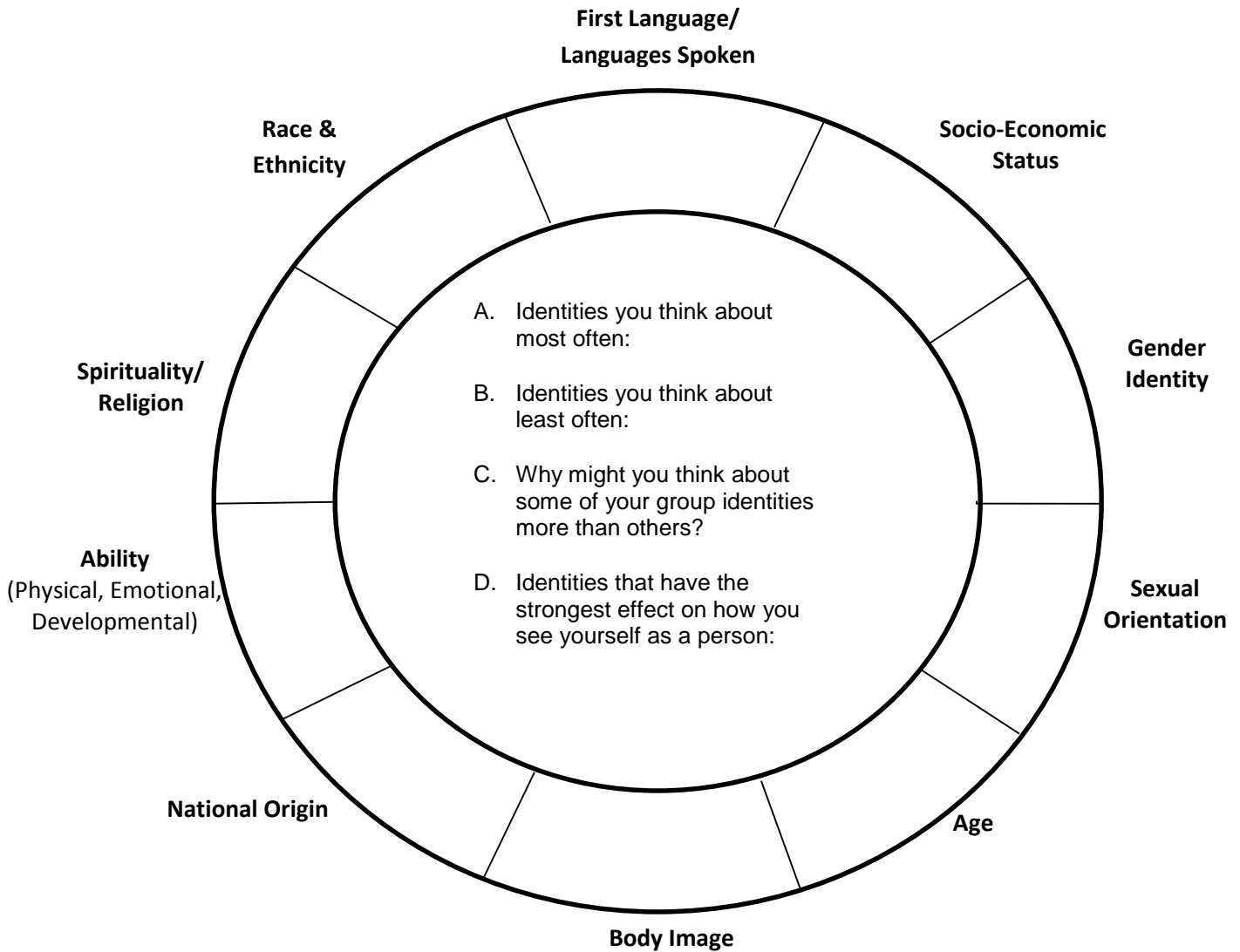


# Social Identity Wheel

This activity highlights the multiple dimensions of our identities. It addresses the relationships between our desires to self-define our identities and the social constructions that label us regardless of how we define ourselves.



1. Think of a story about a time you were especially proud and/or happy to identify with one of the descriptors you used in the circle.
2. Think of a story about a time it was especially painful to be identified with one of your identifiers or descriptors.
